

Fairlawn Local Schools Bedbug and Lice Practice-(10-28-16)

1. Students found or suspected of having bugs of any type will be sent to the school nurse for a thorough inspection.
2. Students with live bugs on their person or belongings will be sent home and parents will be contacted and made aware of treatment options.
3. Siblings or those living in the same residence as any student identified with live bugs will be subject to check by the school nurse.
4. Students sent home for bugs will be subject to a recheck for the following (3) days to assure that the problem has been remedied. (per law students are allowed to return the next day)
5. All areas coming into contact with the infected student including but not limited to classrooms, buses etc. will be immediately and thoroughly sanitized.
6. Students sitting in the general area of the infected student or their belongings will be carefully searched for bugs.
7. If any other bugs are found on or close to other students their parents will be informed by the administration.
8. Chronic cases of infestation will be reported to Children's Services and any other entity who may be able to assist in the elimination of problems.
9. If two or more students in the same class are identified parents of the entire class will be notified of the situation.
10. Students will be excused from school and all work will be accepted upon return to school.
