DC Trip parents and chaperones,

Recently the mayor of Washington DC set some restrictions on visitors to the city due to the current Covid outbreak. The restrictions take effect in the next week and currently have no expiration date. I wanted to take this opportunity to go through these restrictions with you and discuss how they impact our trip.

The first restriction is that to enter restaurants or hotels in Washington DC everyone must be vaccinated for Covid. We are staying at a hotel in Virginia so this does not impact our hotel stay, and while we are currently scheduled to eat twice in DC, we can easily change where we are eating to an out of town location if this restriction is still in place. The second restriction is that visitors who are not vaccinated must show proof of a negative Covid test in the last three days if they are staying in DC for more than 24 hours. Once again, we are staying in a hotel in Virginia overnight, are visiting sights both inside and outside of DC during our trip and are spending one day of our trip visiting sights in Baltimore. This Covid test restriction should have no impact on our trip.

At this time we are still planning to go on the DC trip this summer.


Please understand that these are the restrictions that are currently in place, and we can't control any future restrictions that might be put in place. I have spoken with the owner of our tour company, Classic Student Tours, and he understands the concern and uncertainty that you may be feeling at this time about our trip scheduled for June 5-9. If you wish to drop out of the trip you can do so any time by contacting me at school by March 31st and receive a refund of any money that you have paid minus \$25 to cover expenses that have already been incurred. After April 1st, refunds will be charged a minimum of \$75 and possibly more as we get closer to June.

If you have any questions about the trip, refunds, opting out of the trip or any Covid restrictions please call me at the school. I will do my best to answer any questions that you have.
