Thank you for applying for the Fairlawn Board of Education Scholarship. We are looking for a well-rounded individual who is concerned with academics and active in both extracurricular activities and the community around them. This scholarship will not necessarily be awarded to the top student academically, but rather a student who personifies the above characteristics.

To avoid bias, the application will consist of two parts. Part I will contain your name and address only and will NOT be seen by the judges. It will be given a number which will be put on Part II of your application. Part II contains the information that will be used to determine who receives the Board Scholarship and will be part of the application that is seen by the judges. Individual identities will be known only by the School Counselor.

Important Notes

- One \$500 scholarship will be awarded.
- Applications must be turned in by April 25th to the school counselor.
- Application must be a student in the current graduating class of Fairlawn High School.
- Applicants must be accepted and pursuing a two- or four-year degree at an accredited college or technical school.
- The Board of Education Scholarship Committee will make the student selection.
- You will need to send a copy of the college's first quarter or semester bill to the School Treasurer. A check will be written to the student upon proof of attendance.
- The winner will be announced at graduation.
